What is legal aid?

Information

- Free publications in many languages
- Information services in person and over the phone
- Referrals to other services in your community
- Online legal information and self-help resources

Advice

- Duty counsel (lawyers) provide family or criminal advice and guide clients to fill out their forms
- Family LawLINE provides free advice over the phone from a family lawyer

Representation

- A lawyer to take your case when you have a criminal, child protection, immigration, or serious family law issue

Everyone

- legal information
- criminal duty counsel

People with low incomes

- a lawyer to represent you
- some family advice

Aboriginal people

- advocacy 
- legal information
- family and criminal advice

Services in many languages:

- an interpreter to translate for you when you apply or when you talk to your lawyer
- translated publications in print and online
